

School-Based Health Mobile Unit



Cleveland Clinic Children's School-Based Health Center is a mobile, full-service pediatric office staffed with our healthcare professionals. We provide voluntary, comprehensive healthcare services to students in kindergarten through 12th grade. The mobile unit serves five school districts in the Cleveland area and five Step Forward Head Start preschools (formerly Council for Economic Opportunities).

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School-Based Health Mobile Clinic at Lakewood High School



Cleveland Clinic Children's and the Lakewood Board of Education partnered to launch an innovative in-school medical clinic to serve Lakewood students of all grades, employees of Lakewood City Schools and the Lakewood community. The clinic is staffed with a team of Cleveland Clinic Children's physicians and advanced practitioners who provide a wide range of medical and behavioral health services during the school day.
